Beginner Box and Box Stock Rules and Guidelines

BEGINNER      BOX STOCK

Changes that are allowed to the motor:

1. You may run any spark plug that you like.
2. You may change the spark plug boot.
3. You may run any valve lash that you desire.

Things you MAY NOT do:

1. Modify or alter air box.
2. Remove, alter or leave off air filter, this includes filter foam.
3. Drill out or alter any jets.
4. Modify or alter header, you may not install E.G.T. sensor into header.
5. Muffler may not be altered.
6. No valve spring shims or altering of valve springs in any way.
7. No flywheel timing.
8. No carburetor or restrictor air leak
9. All fuel filters must have one inlet and one outlet. Any and all breathers must be by passed by a T back to the fuel tank.

**BOX STOCK**

1. No valve spring shims or altering of valve spring in any way.
2. No flywheel timing.
3. Carburetor bore maximum 1.029 (will be checked with no go gauge, gauge can not touch slide.)
4. No altering of header (E.G.T. is allowed.)
5. Muffler is non-tech, but must maintain D.B.A. level.
6. No altering of flywheel.
7. No altering of intake manifold, but manifold extensions are allowed. Extension may not protrude more than one quarter inch into manifold.
8. No manifold or extension air leaks.

Broken seals must be reported to tech. Immediately.

Broken seals found prior to qualifying will result in that motors banishment for the night. Reason being, you will have had all week to report and remedy the issue and did not. Exception is beginner box carb seal, carb may be sealed at track.

## PENALTIES AND DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

INFRACTION	PENALTY
1. Air box (beginner box only)	penalty
2. Air filter (beginner box only)	penalty
3. Broken seal (air box)	penalty
4. Air leak	penalty
5. Muffler (beginner box only)	penalty
6. Header	penalty
7. Flywheel timing	DQ
8. Valve spring	DQ
9. Carb jet (beginner box only)	DQ
10. Carburetor	DQ
11. Manifold	DQ

Penalty means you will not be allowed on the track for your next scheduled event. i.e. qualifying, heat, dash or main.

D.Q. means you lose all points for the night and may not return to the track for that night.
